"ENVELOPE FINISH" INSTRUCTIONS

Pin quilt top to backing, right sides together.


Stitch, using a generous seam allowance (3/8" to 1/2" if possible. Leave a six to eight-inch opening

along one side.

Next, roll out batting, then lay stitched quilt top/ backing over batting, with the wrong side of the guilt top next to batting. Trim to size. Pin to secure.

Stitch through all three layers on the same lines. Turn quilt right sides out through opening. Turn corners using a blunt object such as a chop stick. Or try my No-Clip method as seen on YouTube: http://youtu.be/ljwUaL4_pf8

Slipstitch the opening closed with a needle and thread, or edge-stitch with your sewing machine.





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
